²Construction Demolition Debris is defined as asphalt, brick and concrete debris resulting from site work. Additional sampling may be required for materials impacted by PCB containing Mineral Oil. Waste disposal authorization may be required prior to transporting any construction demolition debris to the disposal facility.

³Cadman operates multiple facilities located in North Bend, Black Diamond, Redmond and Monroe.

⁴Pacific Topsoil operates multiple facilities located in Auburn, Tukwila, Bellevue, Woodinville, Issaquah, Kenmore, Seattle, Everett, and Maple Valley.
